Sentences

What is a Sentence?

A group of words that are used to express a thought that makes sense is called a sentence.

All sentences begin with a capital letter.

We use sentences to speak, read and write.

Types of Sentences

- A) **Assertive:** When a sentence states or declares something it is called an Assertive Sentence. An Assertive sentence ends with a full stop.

Example:



The cat caught a rat.



Amy went to the park with her parents.



Pat fell down and hurt his leg.

B) Interrogative: When a sentence asks questions it is an Interrogative sentence.
An Interrogative sentence ends with a question mark.

Example:



When will the bus arrive?



Have you eaten your lunch?



Don't go too close to the fire?

C) Exclamatory: When a sentence expresses a strong feeling it is called an exclamatory sentence.
An exclamatory sentence ends with an exclamation mark.

Example:



Ouch! My leg hurts.



What a superb painting!



How neatly he writes!
